

**Outcome of discussions held with Additional Secretary cum Director General
Labour, Ministry of Labour & Employment govt. of India dated 09-08-2024**

Sr. no.	Item	Outcome
1	Opening of boarding schools for BOC Workers in pursuance to model welfare guidelines dated 1.12.23.	During discussion it is revealed that the BOC Workers Board may fix some ratio/percentage of expenditure to be incurred by the State Govt. for teaching/non teaching staff for these schools. As the labour cess is the only source of revenue of the boards as such for future liabilities it should be brought for consideration of State Government.
2	Opening of facilitation Centres in pursuance to model welfare guidelines dated 1.12.23.	After having a detailed discussion in the meeting it was suggested that this issue may be discussed in the Board Meeting and all the pros and cons must be kept in view to hire facilitation centers on monthly rental basis.
3	To Increase the existing limit of administrative expenses limit upto 10% from 5% under section 24 of BOCW Act, 1996.	During discussion the issue was discussed and as per the prevailing situation of section 24 of Act, the Ministry shown its inability to enhance the limit.
4	To provide list of empanelled agencies to initiate Skill Development Trainings to the beneficiaries of BOC and their Dependents.	It was discussed that the Board may contact to MSDE/ Sector Skill Councils/NSDC to initiate Skill oriented trainings to the beneficiaries and their dependents.
